Education credits continue to be one of the most ever-changing credits. Currently there are two Education Credits for which one may qualify.

AOTC - American Opportunity Tax Credit NOTE: Must have 1098-T from education institution - per IRS Can only be claimed for 4-years of higher education as an eligible student Expenses paid must go toward education that results in an undergraduate or graduate degree or other recognized education credential at an eligible education institution Some of this credit may be refundable LLC - Lifetime Learning Credit NOTE: Must have 1098-T from education institution - per IRS Has no limit on the number of years that one can claim as an eligible student For expenses paid toward education that results in a degree (undergrad & grad) or other recognized education credential skills at an eligible education institution LLC can also be for acquiring or improving job skills None of this credit is refundable

One student, one credit - though, more than one credit can be on the same tax return (example: Parent takes AOTC and dependent has LLC)
